

Candidate Ranking Process for Interviews Invitations:

- 17 Points Max: Academic Potential Score (APS)
 - 6 Points Max: AAS RADT Required General Education Course GPA
 - 11 Points Max: Successful Completion of Required General Education courses
 - 2 pts: MATH 1530 (C or higher)
 - 1 pt: ENGL 1010/1020
 - 2 pts: BIOL 2010 A/B
1 pt: BIOL 2010 C
 - 2 pts: BIOL 2020 A/B
1 pt: BIOL 2020 C
 - 1 pt: Social Science (PSYC 1030 rec.)
 - 1 pt: Humanity/Fine Art
 - 1 pt: COMM 2025
 - 1 pt: ADMN 1306
 - 1 pt: COLS 101 (Zero points if waived)
- 5 Points Max: Observation Score
- 2 Points Max: RADT 1100 (A = 2 pts; B = 1 pt; C = 0 pts; D/F = ineligible)
- 3 Points Max: RADT 1100 Instructor Assessment

Approximately 200% of estimated class size will be selected for an interview to be held in November.

Formal Interview Scoring System

- 3 Points Max: Professional appearance
- 5 Points Max: Medical Experience
- 8 Points Max: Reasoning skills
- 9 Points Max: Personal Interaction Skills
- 8 Points Max: Motivation
