**Athletic Participation**

Participants are student-athletes who, as of the day of a varsity team’s first scheduled contest: (a) are listed by the institution on the varsity team’s roster; (b) receives athletically-related student aid; or (c) practices with the varsity team and receives coaching from one or more varsity coaches.

Any student who satisfies one or more of the criteria above is a participant, including a student on a team the institution designates or defines as junior varsity, freshman, or novice, or a student withheld from competition to preserve eligibility (i.e., a redshirt), or for academic, medical or other reasons.

A student who participates on more than one team is included as a participant on each of the teams, but included only once in the unduplicated count.
