PURPOSE

To delineate the lines of responsibility and authority within the organizational structure of the College.

POLICY

- I. The President of the College is the Chief Executive of the Institution and all its departments, and shall exercise such supervision and direction as will promote the efficient operation of the Institution. The President reports directly to the Chancellor of the Tennessee Board of Regents (TBR).
- II. The following positions report directly to the President of the College:
 - A. Vice President for Academic Affairs
 - B. Vice President for Finance and Administration
 - C. Vice President for Student Affairs
 - D. Vice President for Advancement and Government Relations
 - E. Vice President for Williamson Campus and External Services
 - F. Executive Director to the President Office of Belonging and Student Resources
 - G. Executive Director for Strategic Planning, Effectiveness and Special Projects
 - H. Executive Director of Communications
 - I. Executive Director of Human Resources
 - J. Administrative Assistant to the President
 - K. Internal Auditor
- III. In the absence of the President, temporary responsibility for operation of the College shall be delegated to the Vice Presidents in the order shown in Item II.
- IV. The Organizational Chart, maintained by the Human Resources Office, delineates the functions, operating units, and lines of responsibility and authority for the College. The President is responsible for submitting, for approval by the Chancellor, any administrative revisions.
