PURPOSE

To ensure the College is in compliance with the Tennessee Board of Regents' policy on membership dues and subscriptions paid for from State funds.

DEFINITIONS

- I. Membership Dues or Subscriptions any expenditure from state funds by an institution which entitle subscription of material or membership, associate membership, or participation in activities of an organization.
- II. Organization a group (public or private), association, or society whose purpose is to promote common interests and share information.
- III. Publication directly related to the mission means a publication without which the mission of the College would be impossible or difficult to perform.

POLICY

- I. Columbia State Community College adheres to <u>TBR Guideline G-080</u> relative to membership dues and subscriptions. The TBR guideline is incorporated into this policy by reference herein and may be accessed through the TBR website.
 - Questions regarding the criteria set forth in <u>TBR Guideline G-080</u> should be directed to the Vice President for Finance and Administration.
- II. The President, or his/her designee, must approve all College memberships and subscriptions, with the exception of library subscriptions.
- III. Proposed memberships and subscriptions must be requisitioned following the College's purchasing procedures.
